**LaGrange, Ga. March 16, 2022** – The LaGrange Youth Council will be hosting the "I Sweat Green" Fun Run Fundraiser Saturday, April 9<sup>th</sup> along The Thread Trail.

Registration is \$20 and begins at 8:00 a.m. with the race beginning at 9:00 a.m. 100 percent of the money will go to Calumet Park Neighborhood's Community Garden, Pat's Garden.

"I am passionate about helping my underserved community that is Calumet Park," said LYC Committee Chairperson Devin Dents who came up with the idea of raising money for Pat's Garden. "To start a fun run and help build a community garden for the late Patricia Underwood, a great leader in Calumet Park, is an honor for me."

Ms. Pat owned a corner store in Calumet Park and cared for many of the neighborhood children. In early 2020, Ms. Pat was shot by a stray bullet and killed. Citizens of Calumet Park are set to begin construction on a community garden in her name that will benefit the entire community.

"It is very important to the LaGrange Youth Council that we choose to support causes that will benefit our community. This year, one of our three committees focuses on sustainability," said LaGrange Youth Council Chairperson Milly Criswell. "Hosting a fun run to benefit Pat's Garden is a great way to promote local sustainability while benefitting community members and honoring the legacy of Ms Pat. We invite

everyone to join us and help us raise money for this very worthy cause."

"We're extremely proud of our Youth Council students," said LaGrange Youth Council Advisor Jeremy Andrews. "These young leaders are passionate about this fundraiser and have worked hard to come up with a way to help our community on a local level."

**WHERE:** The Thread at Granger Park on Highland Avenue (Grassy Field adjacent to the LaGrange High School Marching Band field near the LHS parking lot.)
