Construction Officially Begins on the Third Segment of The Thread

LaGrange, Ga. May 21, 2018 – Construction of the third segment of The Thread officially began Monday.

The groundbreaking ceremony was held along Panther Way by LaGrange College. Representatives from Friends of The Thread as well as LaGrange College, City of LaGrange, and the LaGrange-Troup County Chamber of Commerce participated in the groundbreaking ceremony.

This segment of The Thread will connect the “Model Mile” segment by Granger Park to LaGrange College and will be .9 mile. It will extend from West Haralson, North Greenwood Street, Broad Street, Panther Way to Vernon Street around the campus of LaGrange College.

Crews will continue to work along a portion of Broad Street from Waverly Way to Springdale Drive for the next several weeks relocating utility lines underground.

The Thread will be 10 feet wide and include underground utilities as well as lamp posts and an extensive landscaping plan.

This segment of The Thread is expected to be completed by Fall 2018.

More on The Thread: The Thread is an environmentally sensitive, non-motorized, multipurpose trail designed to increase the health and wellness of the community through providing a safe environment in LaGrange, Georgia for fitness, recreation, transportation and special events. Currently, The Thread has a total 29 miles of trails planned in the next nine years.
