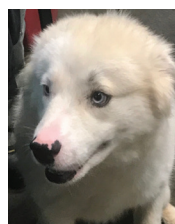


DID YOU KNOW? LaGrange was under a quarantine back in 1901 because of the smallpox virus. According to the Legacy Museum on Main in LaGrange, a sick house was built on the edge of town for those infected with smallpox. Local citizens who had endured and survived the illness served as nurses. Once everyone who had smallpox either survived or died, the house was burned down.
