The American Revolutionary War Hero, the Marquis de Lafayette, rode through our area in 1824 and remarked how the area looked like his wife's home in France, the Chateau de LaGrange. In 1828, Col. Julius Caesar Alford remembered Lafayette's comment and named the community LaGrange.
